



5 days of Ugandan apes

Uganda is one of the amazing places to view wildlife including the endangered species in the savanna grasslands and deep jungle tropical forests. Gorilla trekking in Bwindi impenetrable national park or mgahinga park is a must do activity in this trip and chimpanzee sighting which are common in kibale and other places. Wonderful savannah safaris with excellent wild life viewing are available at queen or Murchison. Our game parks have a variety of wildlife species, birds and reptiles which make this tour a perfect mix of wildlife and primates that you can choose to do in Uganda.

Highlights

Day1 transfer from Entebbe to bwindi impenetrable park

Day 2 Gorilla trekking

Day 3 transfer to queen Elizabeth national park and a min evening game drive

Day 4 min morning game drive then drive to kibale national park for afternoon Chimpanzee trekking

Day 5 transfer to Entebbe

Itinerary

Day 1

We as cyndell tours we will pick you up from Entebbe airport and according to your arrival time we can travel and you get transferred to bwindi impenetrable park via masaka where we can do a min stop over at the equator for photography and coffee break or lunch snack and from here we can do our long road trip up to our reserved hotel in Bwindi for dinner and accommodation.

Day 2

At the UWA briefing point in Bwindi, every group will be assigned a gorilla family to trek for the day in the a company of an armed ranger. Due to the close relationship between humans and these gentle Giants , travellers showing signs of airborne diseases are discouraged from coming too close to mountain gorillas. Alternatively,they can be completely denied a chance of trekking if rangers find it more sever . You are advised to treat flue and cough before traveling. The trekking experience takes between 3 to 5 hours depending on your pace and this involves slippery trails. You may even need to hire a local potter to help you during the trek with carrying luggage and gadgets. Though tracking is the main attraction of the day, a range of stops can provide a relaxed opportunity to spot birds and other types of primates while exploring one of Uganda's loveliest rainforest. Ater trekking you will be rewarded a certificate and we can transfer you back to the lodge.

Day 3

We will wake up early and do a long drive to queen Elizabeth national park after our breakfast. On our arrival we will break off at our booked lodge then do an evening game drive or if possible a night game drive in the park

Day 4

Wake u early morning catch our lovely breakfast in the park and we can start with a game drive through the park to kibale national park for an afternoon Chimpanzee trekking.

Day 5

With a great morning breakfast of no rush we will later start our journey back to Entebbe airport through Kampala capital city for your flight back home.
